Our first stage of regularizing North Akumal project has been completed by gathering the documentations, topography, maps, photometry.
So, we are moving forward with the regulation.

The inicial cost of the first face of the work was for MXN \$300.000 However there are two works that are not required at this time, which are:

- o Urban qualification:
- o Environmental expertise:

the municipality will request these two works it in the future.

We are ready to present our intensions to the municipality.

We are traying to stablish Formal contact with the authorities to value the position of the Association to promote agreements with legal scope for all the habitants of North Akumal.

Dan as the president of the association will personally initiate communication after we receive an appointment from the mayor. Henning is working on this.

The first step is to reach good will agreements, to establish a working group. Ivan Hernandez, our consultant, will assist us in whatever manner is necessary at this stage.

Internal Rules:

Work must be done on internal rules and what we need, such as roads, signs, parking, service areas (water), mobility, windows to the ocean, and constructions.

The strategy for the next 8 to 10 months is to meet with the mayor of Tulum regularly.

In the end, how does this benefit the community after all this work?

- Heritage protection
- Quality of life for those who live in Akumal

And once we are established, we would have the leadership of the area and other bays and community would want to do the same.

There is much work to be done and more to come!
